This training module is a 13-hour workshop intended for professionals working with children who have hearing loss. The curriculum consists mostly of hands-on activities, discussions and some lecture. Some of the highlights are:

- types of hearing loss
- how to read an audiogram
- hearing loss simulation
- troubleshooting hearing equipment
- community resources in BC for families of children who have hearing loss
- effects of hearing loss on development
- inclusion of the child with hearing loss
- how to adapt the home or preschool environment to make it more accessible to a child with hearing loss

Light refreshment for short breaks will be provided. Please bring your own lunch or we can direct you to local amenities.

We are pleased to be able to offer you two ways of attending:

If you reside in the lower mainland we will host you at our state of the art facility for children who have hearing loss and their families. We will be limiting in-person attendance to 20 participants. Priority will be given to ensure the maximum number of clients will be served.

If you reside outside of the lower mainland we hope to offer you the option of attending via our Virtual Hearing Resource Centre. We will be able to offer this in 2 locations ONLY with a minimum of 5 participants per site.
