



Dear families,

You are invited to participate in the PEER program at BC Family Hearing Resource Centre this year, in preparation for your child starting kindergarten in September 2022.

Starting the process for transition into kindergarten now can help ensure you have the information you need to make informed choices, and your child is set up for the most successful transition possible. Specialized group education opportunities such as PEER can provide valuable information and support throughout this process. PEER is designed for families of deaf and hard of hearing children across the province who will be starting Kindergarten in September 2022. PEER consists of:

- Ten evening online parent sessions that run from October 2021 to April 2022, with a final session in October 2022 after your child has started Kindergarten. Each two-hour session is accessible to all and will be recorded, to allow for catch up on any that are missed.
- A parent-participation children's classroom in April 2022, with two options for families (COVID-19 pandemic restrictions allowing): a two-day in-person event in Surrey or a 1-day online event.

PEER discusses the educational options available for your child in BC, and teaches parents about the potential challenges deaf and hard of hearing children can face in school settings. These challenges can present themselves in many ways, and research shows that deaf and hard of hearing children are at risk for social, emotional and academic difficulties. PEER teaches parents how to effectively recognise and advocate for their child's specific communication and access needs in school. Our parent-participation children's classroom gives opportunity for your child to build their self-esteem and identity, and practice self-advocacy skills and strategies for access, all while getting to meet their peers.

The program's full agenda is outlined below.
