The Foundations for Families workshop aims to equip families with the knowledge to make well-informed decisions and the strategies to support their child's development now and in the future.

Foundations for Families also provides an opportunity for parents to ask questions and engage in discussion with staff and other parents who are also experiencing this journey. Connecting with families is a valuable way to build confidence in yourself and self-esteem in your children, while gaining knowledge from others with shared experiences. These friendships and connections can provide continued support as your children graduate from BCFHRC's services and enter the school system.

Foundations for Families workshop will be covering a wide range of topics relating to your child's hearing/deafness, including but not limited to:

- Different ways to communicate
- Strategies to support visual and auditory access
- Creating optimal learning environments
- Describing your child's audiograms
- Equipment options and strategies to keep them on
- Language development (visual and spoken)
- Tips for successful audiology appointments
- Learning about Deaf culture and Deaf Gain
- Connecting with your community
- Building confidence and self-esteem from a young age



Foundations for Families is a fun and interactive hands-on two-day workshop. This workshop is complimentary to the services you are receiving from your Early Interventionist. We aim to not only strengthen your current understanding of these topics, but to expand your knowledge and skills in these areas.
